Mrs O'Neill reported on a number of items –

- Start of prelims for S4 National 5 –
 - Assembly this morning / letter out this week.
 - No study leave – attend as normal.
 - Already sat Std Grade English.
 - Supported study – enhanced tracking and monitoring,
 - Use results in preparation for later in year.
 - No appeals –
 - Can have a recount of marks – if it goes against school, school has to pay costs.
 - Appeal only in exceptional circumstances (passing prelim / failing exam no longer grounds for appeal).
- 27th January S5 / 6 prelim schedule starts –
 - Support and encouragement from now through to January.
- Parental workshop last week – Social Subjects, English, Modern Languages, Science and Maths.
 - Suggestion to take workshops out into the community, change times, offer childcare options and change format e.g. light nights, later starts.
- Managing expectations – getting pupils to believe in their capabilities.
- All private study periods are supervised by senior staff.
- Aim to maintain results progression.
- Transition between all primary schools is very good –
 - PE activity for P7 in October.
 - 13 / 14 November – citizenship day for all primary schools, meeting new people, theme will be a crime investigation activity.
- Incentive programmes running –
 - S1 / 2 Hallowe'en Disco
 - Christmas Disco – Time Capsule for S3 / 4 Ice Disco
 - Winter Wonderland Ball 18th December – S6 Masquerade Ball in school, looking for local businesses to support e.g. Lees.

- 16th December Christmas Celebration – pupils showcase musical talents etc.
- School show to be announced next week.
- £4K raised so far for charity
 - £1627.63 raised for St Andrew's Hospice.
 - STV Appeal – JO'N and member of staff to attend event at Stirling Castle with First Minister.
 - Malawi fundraising – pupils worked over summer to raise funds. Model at school is really good, other schools looking to follow.
- 16th December NL Fashion Show at Motherwell Civic Centre – 4 pupils involved from school, £5 / ticket.
- 25th June – Whole school trip to Blackpool Pleasure Beach.
- Remembrance Service 8th November - £250 raised for Poppy Scotland and ex-member of armed services attended.
- Commonwealth Games –
 - Baton bearer – every secondary school asked to nominate a good role model, does well across school curriculum. Coatbridge High nomination is Christopher Truesdale – under 16 Scotland player, does well academically, modest and school Dux.
 - Hopefully Clyde (games mascot) will be visiting school before Christmas.
- Considering 'Zoning' school due to space available, particularly in inclement weather.
- Make some areas one-way / crowd control – to be phased in in 2014.
- Extension still being progressed.
- Key dates –
 - 12th December – S3 Parents' evening.
 - 20th December – dress down day (last day).
 - 6th January – school starts back.
 - 16th January – P7 information evening.
 - 27th January – S5 / 6 prelims start.
 - 28th January – S4 Parents' evening.
- 33 period week starts in August 2014 for all schools –
 - Various models under consideration – possibly all schools will work to same model.
 - Share resources across all schools and provide access to all.
 - At early stages – looking at options and timetable options.
 - Consultation with parents, pupils and staff on model options.
 - Availability of buses given primary schools use at key times currently.
- Learning & Teaching Policy – draft created
 - Voluntary cross curricular observations – would like to be visited / visit, rolled out next session.
- Praise Reps – pupil praise
 - HT praise cards – teachers can put forward pupils who deserve praise cards from HT (70 given out in the last week rewarding achievements / improvements).
- Visit to Calderwood Village (housing development at Sikeside) –
 - eEo-friendly.
 - Tour of houses being built.
 - Re-visit in a few months and see what has changed.

- Entrepreneurship talk – senior pupils attended.
- Learning hub – next to showhome.
- S3 pupils assembly – profile creation.
